Oakham School has been an integral part of the county of Rutland and the town of Oakham since the inception of the School by Robert Johnson in 1584.

The clients brief was to provide a new Sports and Cricket pavilion to replace the outdated, but much-loved existing Cricket Pavilion 'Stumps', which was no longer capable of meeting the current and future needs of the school.

The new pavilion was to embody the spirit of this progressive school whose core aim is to deliver high quality sports tuition and participation as part of the holistic educational approach within its broad and stimulating curriculum. The design of this new sports pavilion has been developed to meet the high standards of such an eminent sporting institution and the various sports teams that represent it.

The new building seeks to provide the accommodation set out in the client's brief, providing a visually striking but essentially traditional addition to the historic playing fields of Oakham School, respecting its prominent but logical position.

The building consists of a simple, legible layout which is safe and welcoming to both the Oakham School pupils and those from visiting schools. The layout provides four multi-purpose changing rooms with shower / toilet areas for each, whilst also enabling after match teas / meals to be served within a clubroom environment, now decorated to reflect the traditions and history of the Schools Sporting Achievements.
